GUIDELINES FOR ART COMPETITION

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a student of a Tobago Secondary School

RULES

- Schools are allowed to submit multiple entries.
- One entry per student.
- Artwork used from previous/ other competitions will **NOT be accepted**.
- The following media are allowed for artwork:
Oil paint on Canvas, Arcylics, Tempera or
Water paint, Drawings with Pencil, Pens
Ink, Charcoal, Pastel Dyes etc.
- No 3D artwork will be accepted.
- All artwork must be **landscape** in orientation
and submitted on paper/canvas etc.
Size 18in wide by 12in high.
- All artwork that do not meet the required
specification will be automatically disqualified.

WINNERS

- 12 Finalists will be selected.
- Selected artwork will be published in the
Office of the Chief Secretary's 2026 Calendar.
- The winning artwork will be featured on the cover
of the calendar.
- The winning artist will receive \$4,000.00 and
\$10,000.00 will be awarded to his/her school's
art programme.
- Remaining 11 finalists will each receive \$2,000.00. each
- 13th-17th Places will recieve \$1,000.00 consolation
prize each.
- All other participants: \$200 art supply voucher each.

GUIDELINES FOR FILM COMPETITION

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a student of a Tobago Secondary School

RULES

- Two (2) entries per school.
- Film should be no longer than 5 minutes.
- No animation nor animated short film.
- Must be on screen film.
- No sexual depiction/content.
- No weaponry.

- 3rd Prize: \$4,000.00
